## **Apologies:**

# 1. Welcome and apologies

**Noted:** AJHS welcomed the committee and acknowledged the apologies.

# 2. Matters arising from the last meeting

**Noted:** The minutes of the last meeting were agreed by all present with one amendment being made to item 5 which now reads:

ZCF reminded students that when the faculty take over the module evaluation evaluation of the year they can nominate any members of staff (doesn't have to be academic) who has helped you.

**Noted:** SDN confirmed that the email regarding Transfer Reports has been circulated to all PhD students.

**Action:** GAW to send another email to CiCS asking if a top up machine can be installed in the Lewin Computer Room.

**Noted:** HM confirmed that the Library Services have written some guidelines, for students, on how to request books. SDN commented that this information is now in the student handbook.

## 3. Teaching Related Matters

#### 3.1. Level 1

3.1.1. Noted: MS commented that in COM1002 (Foundations of Computer Science) most of the maths content is repeated by the Maths
Department which is an issue for students doing Computer Science with Maths. He asked if there was a way for dual students to do an alternative course, and then maybe do some tutorials for the work which isn't covered by both departments. SDN commented that she has already spoken to the lecturer of COM1002 (Georg Struth). However, the curriculum can't be changed mid-year but hopefully this issue will be resolved by the next academic year.

**Action:** KMR to add this item to the agenda for the first meeting after Christmas in response to the comment from SDN that a decision on how to resolve this issue should have been made by then.

**3.1.2. Noted:** KM commented that students doing Computer Science with Artificial Intelligence encountered problems when trying to register for the Psychology module (PSY101). The Psychology department filled the course before students from Computer Science were able to register. This meant that students had to register for the Philosophy module (PHI126) which many did not want to do.

**Action:** ZCF to speak to the Psychology Department to clarify what went wrong during registration this year and to make them aware of the situation so is doesn't happen again.

**Action:** SDN to find out if the course regulations can be amended to allow students in their second year to take PSY101. SDN commented that she should know if this can be done after January.

#### 3.2. Level 2

3.2.1. Noted: Level 2 students wanted to know why if they are allowed to use the Lewin Computer Room until 9pm they cannot get into the quadrangle after 6pm. They wanted to know if they could get their swipe cards enabled so they can get in the building until the Lewin Computer Room shuts. GAW responded that on 26 October 2010 the data had been sent to the card people to allow students entry to the quadrangle and building after 6pm.

#### 3.3. Level 3

**3.3.1. Noted:** HS commented that the lectures for COM3310 (Mainframe Computing) often over run and that there seems to be too much content in the lectures. He added that these lectures are taught by IBM.

**Action:** AJHS to speak to the academic responsible for COM3310 (Tony Cowling) to make them aware of the issue and to see if anything is going to be done to resolve it.

**3.3.2. Noted:** HS commented that the audio in St Georges Church lecture theatre can often cut out. HS asked who is responsible for this. **Action:** AJHS to contact AV services to report this problem.

#### 3.4. MSc

**3.4.1. Noted:** SB asked if lab classes could be scheduled for 1.5 or two hours. When they have one hour classes, once everyone has managed to log on to the machines it is nearly time to go SB commented that is takes about 10 minutes to log onto the computers. DJA commented that it should not take this long to log onto the computers in the Lewin Computer Room.

**Action:** Support to investigate why it takes so long for students to log onto the machines when there are big groups in the Lewin Computer Room.

**Noted:** RHC commented that it can be a problem in lab classes where the compute room is booked immediately before and after with regards to time constraints. RHC asked if this could be looked into for when next year's time table is sorted.

**Action:** ZCF to take into consideration the above issue when sorting out the 2011/12 time table where possible.

## 4. Feedback from survey of library lending service

**Noted:** HM introduced herself as the faculty librarian and told everyone that that she is based at St Georges Library. HM thanked all the students who completed the library lending service survey.
